August Artist of the Month

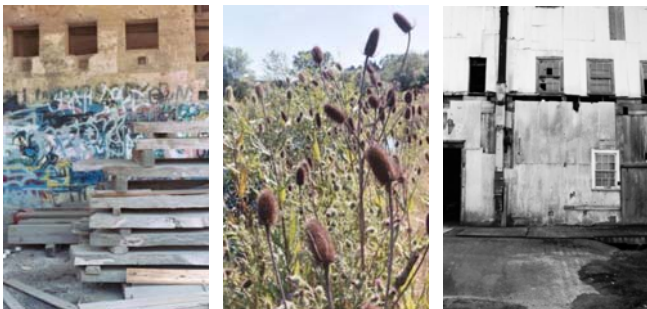

The Second Annual 20/40 Challenge is underway with a great response from area artists. Twenty-one artists have started the challenge which will finish on September 4. The grand viewing will be September 12 at the gallery from 10-5.

The 20/40 Challenge was started in the gallery last year with the participation of eight artists. The artists must produce 20 new pieces of art in 40 days; each piece must fit the 8 x 8 inch board format that is distributed by the gallery. The artist may use any medium that will work with the format and all pieces must relate to a pre-stated theme. We are excited this year to have 21 artists participating and a waiting list for next year.

This year we have a wide variety of mediums represented including oil painting, watercolor painting, mixed media collage, photography, abstract art, mosaics and more.
